Internet in China

- Currently: 79.5 million users
- This is approx. the population of Germany, but only 6.2% of the population of China

Timeline

- September 20th, I 987: First e-mail from China (via Universität Karlsruhe)
- 1994 permanent connection to the Internet
- from 1995 to today: rapid growth of Internet
- portal sites: sina.com, sohu.com, 163.com

The other numbers

- 30,000 Chinese officials working on monitoring and censoring the Web
- 61 Internet users in prison for critizing the government publically (August 2004, RSF)

Banned in China

- Chinese government openly admits Internet censorship
- Hard numbers on banned sites are hard (or even impossible) to research

What gets banned?

- Dissident views: regional conflicts like Taiwan, Tibet
- Falun Gong material
- pornography, gambling
- (occassionally:) foreign language resources (search engines, news)

How does the censorship work?

- Technically, the Great Firewall can only be seen as a black box
- Reporters sans frontières claims Cisco Systems delivered "several thousand routers" to the regime
- Canadian report claims censorship infrastructure built by Nortel Networks

Yes, but HOW does it work?

- Chinese filters use:
 - IP number bans
 - fake DNS replies
 - HTTP keyword manipulation

IP-Bans

- usual suspects: www.tibet.com, www.falundafa.ca
- news and blogging sites: www.bbc.co.uk (at least temporarily), blogger.com, typepad.com
- random and unexplicable bans come and go (experimental setup? false positives?)

DNS

- some sites are also blocked on a DNS level
- using a foreign DNS may not work, DNS manipulation seems to come from within the Chinese network infrastructure

HTTP Keyword Blocking

- Attempt to make certain sites unaccessable for search engine users
- Keyword blocking looks for what looks like HTTP traffic with banned keywords

What to keep in mind

- Censorship seems to focus on the World Wide Web, but e-mail surveillance is probable
- Many Chinese access the Internet through wangba (网吧), or Internet cafés.
 - This adds another level of (social) control

How to circumvent censorship

- Use different search engines
 - Foreign versions of Google (google.de)
 don't seem to be censored
- Use the Coral proxy
 - append nyud.net:8090 to your URL or use the handy Mozilla plug-in

Circumvention for geeks

- TOR
- Java ANON Proxy
- tunneling

Will geeks save the world?

- Most methods assume that you have your own PC
- To most people in China, the Internet is still irrelevant
- Massive anti-Americanism recently decreased popularity of Western concepts of "liberty" and "democracy".
